Coach's Corner

Better Chips Lead to Better Scores

Many golfers hit too many chip shots fat or thin. They might stub the club head into the ground behind the ball and then on the other blade the ball across the green. This inconsistent contact between the club and the ball means they never have good distance control when chipping.

Here is a simple check point for good chipping. Your hands never flip at impact with the ball.



The picture of the left shows the hands flipping. Don't do this. The picture of the right shows the hands moving forward and not flipping. This is the secret. Remember practice makes perfect. Enjoy
